## 4 easy steps to a beautiful finish...



1. Apply a generous coating of stripper to the surface. Let stand for 10-20 minutes or until paint has softened.



2. Use a scraper, brush or steel wool to remove softened layers; or try rubbing the surface with sawdust.



3. Clean the area with a lint-free cloth dampened with stripper to remove all traces of loosened paint.



4. Wipe the surface clean with another cloth dampened with Recordsol Paint Thinner.

*Heirloom® will not harm veneer or raise the wood grain. Do not use on synthetic fabrics, plastic vinyl, rubber or asphalt.*

**Caution:** It is recommended to work in a well ventilated area to avoid inhaling vapours. If working in an enclosed area, wear a mask designed for organic vapours.
