- Cleans garage floors and driveways
- Aids in restoring paint brushes

### TSP – Trisodium Phosphate

TSP is a heavy duty all-purpose cleaner that is well known by professional painters and window cleaners as an excellent cleaner for removing stubborn grease stains on walls and windows. Now you can achieve top-quality cleaning results yourself.

Recochem's TSP is available both in powder and liquid form. It is a versatile cleaner that, by varying dilutions, is used to get rid of tough oil and grease stains. The extra strength liquid spray version is biodegradable and ready to use, with the convenience of direct application on soiled surfaces. TSP Liquid Concentrate is used directly on tough stains, and it can also be diluted for use around the home.

### As a household cleaner, TSP is excellent for:

- Removing stains on kitchen and bathroom floors
- Removing finger marks and grease from walls
- Cleaning kitchen exhaust filters
- Cleaning soot film from fireplace brick

For stubborn stains around the house, TSP powder is a good choice. When preparing for cleaning floors and bathroom walls, mix one part TSP to twenty parts warm water (1:20 parts volume). For a stronger solution, mix one part TSP to ten parts warm water (1:10) in a bucket of water for cleaning kitchen exhaust hood filters, fireplace brick or barbecue tools.

### Preparing for painting:

- Removes grease and dirt film from walls for better paint adhesion
- Prepares surfaces for painting
- Cleans brushes

Mix one part TSP to twenty parts warm water (1:20) and wash down walls in preparation for painting. Or spray Liquid TSP directly on walls and rinse away with clean water to remove greasy residues. When washing, always work from bottom up to prevent drip marks and streaks on walls. Soak paint brushes in a solution of TSP to restore their softness.

### In the garage:

- Removes grease and oil stains from garage floors and driveways

Apply a paste of powder TSP and water to oil and grease stains on garage floors and driveways and allow the mixture to soak, then rinse off. To ensure a good adhesion of driveway sealer, use a strong solution of water and TSP powder or concentrate to wash down driveways before application. You can also spray or pour liquid concentrate directly on oil and grease stains, let stand for 15 minutes and then rinse away.

We recommend wearing rubber gloves and goggles and avoiding prolonged skin contact when using this product.
